We understand that the dangers and risks of playing or practicing of play/participate in a sport may result not only in serious injury, but in a serious impairment of any future abilities to earn a living, to engage in other business, social and recreational activities, and generally to enjoy life.

Therefore, the participant named below along with his/her parent/guardian agree to assume all risks incidental to the use of said facilities and shall be solely responsible for any and all accidents and injuries to persons and property (including death) arising out of or in connection with the event, use of facilities, its appurtenances and the surround grounds and hereby consents agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the People of the City of North Tonawanda and the Youth, Recreation and Parks Department and its employees and representatives from any and all claims, suits, actions, damages and cost of every nature and description arising out of or relating to the use of the facilities, its appurtenances and the surround grounds or the violation by said participant, its agents, employees or contractors of any law, code, order, ordinance rule or regulation in connection therewith.
