

## Household Hazardous Waste

Starting January 28, 2010, the Niagara County Refuse Disposal District has begun accepting Household Hazardous Waste from Niagara County residents at its satellite collection facility located at the North Tonawanda Public Works Garage at 758 Erie Avenue. This facility is a joint effort between the Refuse District and the City to reduce the amount of Household Hazardous Waste from the residential curbside garbage collection stream.

Typical hazardous waste items found in household waste include mercury from fluorescent light bulbs, thermostats and thermometers; paint thinners and strippers; stains and varnishes; and weed killers and fertilizers.
