NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SEALED PROPOSALS for the Main Street Green Infrastructure Improvements Project as called for by the Contract, in accordance with plans and specifications thereof, will be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer of the City of North Tonawanda, New York, until 11:00 am, Prevailing Time, November 12, 2019 at which time they will be publicly opened.

A copy of the Contract Documents is on file and is available for inspection during the usual business hours at the office of the City Engineer in the City Hall, 216 Payne Avenue, North Tonawanda, New York; and at Avalon Document Services, 741 Main Street, Buffalo, NY 14203.

The project consists of 820± feet of full depth street pavement reconstruction, including new curbs, sidewalks, street lighting, street trees and green stormwater management practices to promote the infiltration of stormwater run-off.

Drawings and specifications can be picked up at Avalon Document printing at 741 Main Street, Buffalo, NY 14203, upon the non-refundable payment of \$50.00 per set. Payment can be made by credit card or by a check made payable to Avalon Document Services.

Each proposal must be accompanied by cash, a certified check payable to the City of North Tonawanda, or bid bond, having as surety thereon a surety company acceptable to the City Attorney, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the base bid, conditioned that, if his proposal is accepted, he will enter into a contract for the same, and that he will execute any such further security as may be required for the faithful performance of the contract.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 am prevailing time on October 30, 2019 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room of City Hall at 216 Payne Avenue, North Tonawanda, NY. Attendance at the pre-bid meeting is recommended but is not mandatory.

The State of New York has established a goal of 30% participation by Minority/Women Business Enterprises (MWBE) on the value of all State Contracts. The CONTRACTOR is required to submit all of the required forms found in Appendix B, General Provisions - Paragraph D with their bid (Exhibits G-2, G-3 and G-4). The CONTRACTOR is expected to make a good faith effort to meet this goal and provide an explanation of how this requirement will be met on the entire project.

All bids shall be submitted to the **City Clerk/Treasurer's office in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of North Tonawanda** and shall be plainly marked on the outside with the Contractor's name and title of the bid. Bids for contracts shall be designated as Project No. 2018-03; Main Street Green Infrastructure Improvement Project.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The minimum wage rates to be paid to laborers and mechanics engaged in the construction of this project shall be the latest wage rates established by the State Industrial Commissioner.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids for failure to comply with the requirements of the Contract Documents but may, at its discretion, waive any informalities or irregularities.

The Owner further reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to award a contract which, in its judgment, is in the best interest of the Owner.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the opening thereof, but may withdraw same at any time prior to the opening thereof. Bidder must sign the statement of non-collusion in accordance with Chapter 751 of the Laws of the State of New York.
