5. Judges reserve the right to change participant's selected category.
6. The participates are encouraged to follow the below criteria for choosing their category:

Griswold:

- Non-conventional methods of decorating; in an over the top fashion
- Use every space of house and lawn with a mixture of lights

Classic:

- Lighting is conventional and older fashion looking
- Use wreaths, garland, deer, and trees as light displays

Themed:

- Stick to one idea or one lighting concept
- Use one for of display such as gingerbread, Santa's workshop or religion

Business:

- Window or store front display
- Holiday theme like Disney or snowmen
