Chapter 98. Water

98-6 Tester of Meters

- A. All city owned meters are tested for accuracy of registration at flow rates and test flow quantities in accordance with the American Water Works Association Standard C705 before installation.
- B. A city owned meter may be tested at the request of a property owner. If the test reveals that the meter is not within the limits of accuracy according to the standards of the American Water Works Association, the meter shall be replaced at no charge to the owner and there shall be no charge for the test. A fee of \$55 will be charged if the city meter is found to be within the limits of accuracy. The property owner shall be billed for meter testing within the first water bill rendered after the date of such test.
- C. To ensure reliable meter measurements, all privately owned meters that have been installed for less than 30 years must be tested periodically and must comply with American Water Works Association Standard C705. A meter installed for 30 years or more, is ineligible for testing and must be replaced. A test certificate must be filed with the water department. The meter test frequency is determined by meter size.
- D. Meter test schedule:

E. The City of North Tonawanda reserves the right to require that any water meter test is witnessed by the Plumbing Inspector or Code Enforcement Officer.
