MOVED by Alderman Zadzilka SECONDED by Alderman Pecoraro That the Common Council at a regular meeting, held at City Hall, 216 Payne Avenue, North Tonawanda, New York at 6:30 p.m. on May 15, 2018, an Agreement between the City of North Tonawanda, the North Tonawanda City School District, Sportsplex Inc. and Twin Cities Community Outreach Inc. was passed and reads as follows:

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The purpose of this letter (this "<u>Agreement</u>") is to memorialize the agreement among **NORTH TONAWANDA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT**, a New York municipal corporation organized and existing under the Education Law of the State of New York with offices at 175 Humphrey Street, North Tonawanda, NY 14120 (the "<u>School District</u>"), the **CITY OF NORTH TONAWANDA**, a New York municipal corporation with offices at 216 Payne Avenue, North Tonawanda, NY 14120 (the "<u>City</u>"), **SPORTSPLEX INC.**, a New York corporation with offices at 90 Ridge Road, North Tonawanda, NY 14120 ("<u>Sportsplex</u>"), and **TWIN CITIES COMMUNITY OUTREACH INC.**, a New York not-for-profit corporation with offices at 100 Ridge Road, North Tonawanda, NY 14120 ("<u>Twin Cities</u>") regarding the repair and repaving of portions of the 50 feet wide strip of land improved by a private access road which is shown crosshatched and labeled "50 WIDE EASEMENT" on the Property sketch attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** (the "<u>Roadway</u>").

The School District, as owner of the real property known a 98 Ridge Street, North Tonawanda, New York (Tax Parcel No. 182.05-2-9.112) and the real property commonly known as 110 Ridge Street, North Tonawanda, New York (Tax Parcel No. 182.05-2-9.2). Sportsplex, as owner of the real property known as 90 Ridge Street, North Tonawanda, New York (Tax Parcel No. 182.05-2-9.12), and Twin Cities, as owner of the real property known as 100 Ridge Street, North Tonawanda, New York (Tax Parcel No. 182.05-2-9.12), and Twin Cities, as owner of the real property known as 100 Ridge Street, North Tonawanda, New York (Tax Parcel No. 182.5-2-9.111), each use the Roadway for ingress and egress to and from their respective properties, and portions of the Roadway are in need of repaying.

The School District, Sportsplex, and Twin Cities (collectively, the "<u>Property Owners</u>") and the City wish to arrange for the repaying of certain portions of the Roadway, in the manner and on the terms and conditions set forth below.

1. <u>The Project</u>. The City hereby agrees to perform the repaving work more particularly described in the letter from the City Department of Public Works dated April 4, 2018 and attachments, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** (collectively, the "<u>City Work Letter</u>"), as supplemented by this Agreement, and any work reasonably inferable therefrom (the "<u>Work</u>"), in connection with the Roadway, in accordance with the terms, covenants, and conditions of this Agreement.

2. <u>Specifications and Requirements</u>. The City, in performing the Work, shall comply with the specifications and requirements described in the City Work Letter and in accordance with applicable City ordinances, codes, and other requirements (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "<u>City Specifications and Requirements</u>").

3. <u>Permits and Licenses</u>. The City shall obtain, at its expense, any necessary permits, licenses, approvals for the Work.

4. <u>Contingency for Board of Education Approval</u>. This Agreement is contingent upon and shall not become effective unless and until it is approved by the School District's Board of Education ("<u>Board of Education Approval</u>").

5. <u>Commencement and Completion of Work</u>. The City shall obtain any necessary permits, and shall commence the Work within fifteen (15) days after the School District notifies the City that the Board of Education Approval (as hereinafter defined) has been granted (the "<u>Commencement Date</u>"). The City shall substantially complete all of the Work within thirty (30) days after the Commencement Date (the "<u>Completion Date</u>"), unless prevented from doing by any act or neglect of any of the Property Owners, or other circumstances beyond the control of the City.

6. <u>Labor, Materials and Equipment</u>. Subject to the Property Owner's obligations described below to compensate the City for all costs of the labor and materials required in connection with the Work, the City shall provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary for the Work, and will perform the Work in good workmanlike manner in accordance with all City Specifications and Requirements.

7. <u>Cost of Materials</u>. Sportsplex and Twin Cities shall be responsible for paying the full **\$11,575.08** cost of the materials required for the Work, as described in the City Work Letter, to the City, in advance, before the Commencement Date of the Work, as follows:

(a) Sportsplex contribution: \$6,575.08
(b) Twin Cities contribution: \$5,000.00 Total \$11,575.08

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8. <u>Cost of Labor</u>. The School District shall be responsible for paying the full **\$5,109.40** cost of the labor required for the Work, as described in the City Work Letter, upon completion of the Work, by transferring to the City the title to a used school bus (the "<u>School</u> <u>Bus</u>"), which is more particularly described below, and which has an estimated current market value that is roughly equivalent to such labor cost:

Bus 90 Year 2008 Make/model Ford E-350 VIN – 1FD3E35P68DB23596.

Title to the School Bus shall be transferred by the School District to the City by Bill of Sale upon completion of the Work, and the City shall accept the School Bus in its "AS IS" condition, without any representations or warranties by the School District as to the condition of the School Bus.

9. <u>Site Supervision</u>. During the performance of the Work, the City shall keep a competent superintendent at the project site, and the City shall be solely responsible for taking such steps as are reasonably necessary to ensure public safety during the performance of the Work.

10. <u>Insurance</u>. Prior to commencing the Work, City shall, at its sole cost and expense, provide the School District, Sportsplex, and Twin Cities with a certificate of liability insurance protecting and indemnifying the City and each of the Property Owners against personal injury, death, and property damage arising in connection with the Work, with limits of not less than \$2 million per occurrence and \$4 million in the aggregate. The School District, Sportsplex, and Twin Cities shall each be named as certificate holders and as additional insureds on such certificate of liability insurance.

11. Indemnification. The City shall at all times defend, indemnify and hold the Property Owners (and each of them) harmless from and against any and all claims, demands and actions and all related costs and expenses (including attorneys' fees), damages, losses, injury and liabilities of every kind and nature however caused, for personal injuries, death and/or property damage arising out of or resulting from the Work, the City's activities on or about the project site, or any act or failure to act by the City, regardless of whether such Claims are asserted by the Property Owners (or any of them), the City, third parties, or their respective agents, contractors, employees, invitees, or licensees. Termination of this Agreement shall not affect the continuing obligation of the City as an indemnitor for any claim, demand, action, etc. referred to in this section which relates to or arose out of an act or omission which took place prior to the termination of this Agreement. If any provision of this indemnification is held by a court to be invalid or void, the remaining portions shall survive.

12. <u>Change Orders</u>. No change orders or change directives which change the scope of the Work or increase the cost of labor or cost of materials shall be effective unless signed by the City, the School District, Sportsplex, and Twin Cities.

13. <u>Default</u>. If the City defaults or persistently fails or neglects to carry out the Work in accordance with this Agreement, or otherwise fails to comply with the terms, covenants and provisions of this Agreement, the Property Owners, after (7) days' written notice to the City, and without prejudice to any other remedy such Property Owners may have, may terminate this Agreement by written notice to the City.

14. <u>Miscellaneous</u>.

(a) Entire Agreement. This Agreement, including the attachments and any other materials referred to therein, constitutes the entire Agreement by and among the City, the School District, Sportsplex, and Twin Cities relating to the proposed Work, and is intended to supersede any prior Agreements among the parties with respect to the same.

(b) Modification. This Agreement shall not be amended or supplemented except by a written instrument signed by the City, the School District, Sportsplex, and Twin Cities.

(c) Authority. By executing this Agreement, the individuals executing this Agreement hereby represent and warrant that they have the authority to bind the party on whose behalf such individual has executed.

(d) Counterparts and Electronic Delivery. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, and may be executed and delivered by facsimile or e-mail transmission.

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Facsimile or e-mail copies of the fully executed Agreement shall have the same force and effect as originals and the same admissibility in evidence as an Agreement containing an original signature. The parties hereby waive any objection to the contrary.

This will be a onetime City Assistance for said improvements, subject to further review by the City Attorney.

Re: Main Street Green Infrastructure Proposals

Dear Honorable Body:

As you are aware, it was announced in October 2017 that the City of North Tonawanda will be the recipient of \$2,500,000 from the New York State Smart Growth Community Fund. This program is intended to support Smart Growth public investments that make downtown communities more pedestrian friendly, accessible, attractive, and dynamic in order to attract new development, support, existing businesses and services, and improve the quality of life for downtown residents. In December 2017, the City also received \$353,000 from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation to make green infrastructure improvements to the Main Street corridor from Island Street to Thompson Street.

Green infrastructure improvements to this stretch of Main Street include structural soils and street trees, reduction in pavement width to lower impervious area, and installation of permeable pavement. Additionally, relocation of overhead utilities, and the addition of street lighting and other aesthetic improvements will also be implemented to enhance the look of this Main Street corridor.

To complete the Main Street Green Infrastructure Improvements Project, the City intends to procure the services of a professional engineering firm. This firm's responsibilities will include a public engagement process to solicit ideas and input for North Tonawanda's residents, design of the identified improvements and implementation assistance through the construction and installation stages.

A request for proposals was issued in April 2018 and the City received three proposals from professional firms. A review committee was convened with representation from City Engineering, Community Development, Lumber City Development Corporation, and Department of Public Works, to review the proposals and provide a recommendation to the Council.

Upon review the committee is recommending the City select the proposal submitted by Erdman Anthony (EA). EA is a local firm with experience in engineering design and green infrastructure improvements. EA is partnering with Joy Kuebler Landscape Architect, PC, a North Tonawanda design firm, to fulfill the projects MWBE goals. The review committee felt the team assembled by Erdman Anthony demonstrated the experience, creativity, and capacity to complete this project for the City at a reasonable fee.

I am hereby requesting this honorable body consider selecting Erdman Anthony to complete the Main Street Green Infrastructure Improvements Project and authorize the Mayor to sign a contract with Erdman Anthony, pending review and approval by the City Attorney, for the proposed fee of \$121,630.00.
