WHEREAS, President Donald Trump and the Federal Government have sent an additional 2,000 ventilators to be distributed across New York State;

WHEREAS, the cases of Covid-19 in the Western New York Region continue to grow;

WHEREAS, nurses, doctors, and first responders in North Tonawanda and the greater Western New York area must have the support of their elected leaders to maintain their own equipment for the safety of themselves and their patients;

WHEREAS, New York's upstate-downstate divide has never been more evident than in the use of US Military to seize and redistribute health equipment, instead of utilizing the reserves at the State Governments' disposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the North Tonawanda Common Council strongly oppose the use of military personnel to take PPE from Western New York facilities.
