





SEALED PROPOSALS for the CITY OF NORTH TONAWANDA, LOCAL PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ACTION PLAN (PSAP) as called for by the Contract, in accordance with plans and specifications thereof, will be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer of the City of North Tonawanda, New York, until 11:00 AM, Prevailing Time, TUESDAY, MAY 12, at which time they will be publicly opened. Instructions will be posted on the entrance to City Hall providing detailed instructions for receiving bids and bid opening.

The project consists of improvements to pedestrian facilities at four signalized intersections in the City of North Tonawanda. Improvements include the addition of pedestrian signals and related equipment and upgrading sidewalk curb ramps not meeting current standards. Disturbed pavements and pavement markings will be restored and signs replaced as needed to meet current standards and PSAP guidance.

Each proposal must be accompanied by cash, a certified check payable to the City of North Tonawanda, or bid bond, having as surety thereon a surety company acceptable to the City Attorney, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the base bid, conditioned that, if his proposal is accepted, he will enter into a contract for the same, and that he will execute any such further security as may be required for the faithful performance of the contract.

The General Provisions of Contract, Contract Forms of Proposal, Agreement, Bonds, General Construction Specifications, Materials of Construction that are contained in the specifications will be adhered to in all respects.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The minimum wage rates to be paid to laborers and mechanics engaged in the construction of this project shall be the latest wage rates established by the State Industrial Commissioner and Federal Government.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids for failure to comply with the requirements of the Contract Documents but may, at its discretion, waive any informalities or irregularities.

The Owner further reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to award a contract which, in its judgment, is in the best interest of the Owner.



**COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
SETTLEMENT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

The City of North Tonawanda, New York (the “City”) and the North Tonawanda Police Benevolent Association (the “Association”) are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement (the “Agreement”), with the term of January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2020. The parties’ negotiating teams have reached agreement on the terms of a successor to the Agreement, which they desire to record in this Memorandum of Agreement.

The new agreement shall be for the period of January 1, 2021 through and including December 31, 2022, and shall be the same as the aforementioned Agreement except for the following changes:

- A. **Modify Article 7, Section 7.1 Compensation:** Modify Compensation in the Salary Schedule in Section 7.1, and for the duration of the agreement in Section 7.1 consistent with the following:
 - January 1, 2021: 2% salary schedule increase
 - January 1, 2022: 2% salary schedule increase

 - B. **Modify Article 12, Section 12.5 (Waiver of Medical Insurance)** Modify the Memorandum of Agreement on the Waiver of Health Insurance duly executed on or about February 8, 2019 and due to expire on December 31, 2020 and extend same until December 31, 2022.
- II. All other Articles and Sections of the CBA shall remain the same and in effect until a successor agreement is negotiated.



TENTATIVE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN

AND THE NORTH TONAWANDA PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTERS, IAFF, LOCAL 1333

WHEREAS, the City of North Tonawanda ("City") and the North Tonawanda Professional Firefighters, IAFF Local 1333 ("Union") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement effective January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2020; and

NOW THEREFORE, the City and Union have reached the following Tentative Agreement for a new collective bargaining agreement as a result of negotiations between the City and the Union:

1. Salaries will be increased by two percent effective January 1, 2021 and January 1, 2022.
2. The term of the new collective bargaining agreement will be January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2022.
3. All other terms and conditions of employment set forth in the parties' collective bargaining agreement, Memoranda of Operations, Memoranda of Understandings, and Memoranda of Agreements will remain in full force and effect.
4. This Tentative Agreement is subject to ratification by the Union's membership and the City Council.





Traffic Safety Minutes:

The April 20, 2020 meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1845 hours via phone. Roll call showed the following members present: R. Frank, J. Sikora, M. Daigler, M. Meisenburg, M. Lemke, A. DiBernardo, M. Anastasi, D. Grinnell. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted, the following new concerns/requests were discussed, and recommendations made.

1. Member Frank received a complaint from Joseph Mittiga who reported that vehicles are parking on the terrace at 315 Schenck Street. Frank advised Mittiga that the residents are allowed to park on the terrace due to not having a driveway or any other parking on the property. This decision was based off past discussions regarding terrace parking with the previous City Engineer, Dale Marshall.

*** All requests for a terrace parking permit will be checked by the Traffic Safety Committee and will be based on each individual property. The decision will be determined by taking in all aspects of that particular property, which include safety, line of sight, having a prior concrete terrace and other parking options.

2. Councilman Bob Schmigel requested information regarding the road that is behind the Mid City Plaza. Member Daigler informed Schmigel that the road is not city property.
3. Councilman Bob Schmigel requested information regarding the commercial vehicle parking in the city. Member Daigler gave Schmigel the commercial vehicle rules and regulations.
4. Mayor Pappas requested that Webster Street be looked at for proper parking lines. Member Daigler is working with City Engineer, Chelsea Spahr, regarding the "Downtown Project". Daigler and Spahr will be working together to make sure proper parking lines and signage are in the downtown area. All safety measures will be discussed and properly attended to.
5. Member Daigler changed the parking signs along the Erie Canal Bike Path on Sweeney Street. The signs were changed to stay in compliance with the state.

6. Amanda Licht of 378 Schenck Street requested a terrace parking permit. The committee will look into the request and make a decision in May.






