## AMENDMENT TO THE NORTH TONAWANDA CITY CODE CHAPTER 45- SOLID WASTE

MOVED by Alderman DiBernardo SECONDED by Alderman Zadzilka
That the Common Council at a regular meeting, held at City Hall, 216 Payne Avenue, North Tonawanda, New York at 6:30 p.m. on April 6, 2021 approves the Amendment to Section 45 of the City Code of the City of North Tonawanda - Solid Waste and it reads as follows:

## CHAPTER 45 - SOLID WASTE

## §45-15 Penalties for Offenses.

E. Notwithstanding the penalties set forth above, unauthorized dumping shall be punishable by a mandatory fine of $\$ 1,000$.
F. Violations of this ordinance shall be reported to the Police Department, which shall have the responsibility of enforcing this ordinance and of issuing appearance tickets, when necessary
§45-16 Removal by city; charges.
A. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to maintain or use any plot or parcel of land in the City as a dump or a place for the reception of and disposition of waste materials, heavy pickup, garbage, rubbish or refuse as defined in this chapter. It shall be the duty of every owner of any such plot or parcel of land to remove or cause to be removed from the premises any uncontained exterior accumulation of such materials described herein within 72 hours of the notice of noncompliance from the City.
B. Noncompliance; notice to correct. If the provisions of this section are not complied with, the Superintendent of Public Works, Chief of Police or their designee shall cause to be served a written notice upon the owner to comply with the provisions of Subsections A and C.
C. Performance of work by City. If the person upon whom the notice provided for in Subsection B is served neglects or refuses to remove or cause to be removed such garbage, rubbish, refuse or wastes within 72 hours after receipt of such notice or if no person can be found in the City who either is or claims to be the owner of such lot or land or who either represents or claims to represent such owner, the Department of Public Works shall cause such garbage, rubbish, refuse or wastes to be removed.

D, Collection of costs by City. The actual cost to the City for removing any such accumulated wastes as certified by the Superintendent of Public works, plus $\$ 125$ for inspection and any other additional costs incurred in connection with its enforcement herewith, shall be certified by the Department of Public Works to the City Treasurer and shall thereupon become and be a lien upon the property on which any such accumulated wastes as provided in this chapter were located and shall be added to and become and form a part of the taxes next to be assessed and levied upon such lot or land and shall bear interest at the same rate as taxes and shall be collected and enforced in the same manner as general City taxes.

## §45-17 Severability; supersession of legislation.

A. The declaration of any section of this ordinance by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid shall not invalidate the entire ordinance, but only the part thereof so declared to be invalid, and the remainder of said ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
B. Any and all laws, regulations or ordinances affecting the collection of garbage and refuse to the City of North Tonawanda are hereby declared to be superseded by this ordinance.

## §45-18 When effective.

This ordinance shall take effect upon being adopted by the Common Council and publication in the official newspaper of the City of North Tonawanda.

Traffic Safety Minutes:

The April 2021 meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1900 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: R. Frank, J. Sikora, M. Meisenburg, M. Lemke, D. Grinnell, A. DiBernardo. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted, the following new concerns/requests were discussed, and recommendations made.
1.) Councilman Tylec had a complaint regarding speeding and cross walk problems on Sweeney Street. The complainant wants the committee to look into placing a stop sign on Sweeney Street in the area of Division Street and Spruce Street with a possible crosswalk to the bike path. A crosswalk can not be put in at this time due to there not being a sidewalk on the south side of Sweeney Street. The bike path has crossings already which were designed by the City Engineer when the bike path was built. Member Frank has had the traffic officer and special speeding enforcement details on Sweeney Street. There have been tickets written and the average speed is 35 mph . The speed sign was also put there for 10 days and will be put back out there over the next several months. Stop sign request denied. Sweeney Street will be monitored.
*2. Councilman Tylec had a request from the owner of Witter's, Josh Ramos, who asked for a handicap sign near is business. The committee agrees with the request and is asking the council to approve a handicap spot on the south west corner of Schenck Street. This part of the street has a cutout in the street which would help with someone getting out of a vehicle safely. Request approved with approval from the council.
3.) Councilman Tylec had a request for "Children at Play" signs on Deerfield Drive right after the bend from Ohio Street. These signs are designated for schools, parks and day cares. Request denied.
4.) Councilman Tylec stated that the building owner at Warner and Ward Road has multiple issues with people driving over the sidewalk due there not being curbs. Member Frank has spoken with DPW Superintendent, Mark Zellner. Zellner stated that the intersection is on the list to be worked on this summer. The committee will work with Zellner to help improve the intersection.
5.) The committee received a request to put up a stop sign at Schenck Street and Bryant Street. There is a stop sign at the intersections before and after that intersection therefore another stop sign is not needed. Request denied.
6.) The committee received a request from David Horn from Esther Street. Horn would like to have "No Parking" signs put up on Ester Street from Freeman Street to Nash Road. There is currently "No Parking" signs that go from the first house on Esther Street to Nash Road. The committee is willing to grant the request and advised Horn to speak to his neighbors about what side they would like the signs on.
4. 7. The committee received a complaint from the North Tonawanda School Bus Supervisor, Thomas Witt. Witt states that the buses have a hard time getting down Drake Drive due to the parking on both sides of the street. Committee members looked at the street and felt that putting up "No Parking" signs up on the south side of St. Joseph Street by Drake Drive would be better due to there not being any houses/driveways on that side. Frank spoke with Witt who agreed to change his bus route from Drake Drive to St. Josephs Drive which would give his bus drivers more room. Request granted with approval from the council.
