Please be advised that our present Assistant Building Inspector John Stahlman is retiring from the position effective May 28, 2021, his last day will be May 21, 2021.

On May 10, 2021 I posted the position with the union with a reply date of May 14,2021. I received no reply to said posting. On May 6, 2021 I requested a certified eligible list from Civil Service, they have commenced the canvassing process with a response date of May 21, 2021 which I received on Monday. There are four applicants that responded to the canvass letter from Civil Service and Mr. Kubiniec is second on the list, Dave Conti, who is not interested in the position being first. The other two respondents are not City residents.

Mr. Kubiniec has been our Plumbing Inspector for the last five years and has done a great job in that position, he is also State Certified as a Code Enforcement Officer, a requirement for this position. The certification is a six week fully paid process. Mr. Kubiniec is not a city resident.

It is my intent to offer Mr. Kubiniec the position of Assistant Building Inspector, however this will require that the Council waive the residency requirement for the position, and since there are no other residents on the list I therefore respectfully request that the Council waive said requirement, additionally I also request that the Council consider raising the starting pay above the \$51,964 minimum. The position presently is at par with the Electrical Inspectors pay.
