Traffic Safety Minutes:

NOV 0 1 2021

The October 2021 meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1730 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: R. Frank, J. Sikora, M. Meisenburg, M. Daigler, M. Lemke, M. Anastasi, D. Grinnell, A. DiBernardo. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted, the following new concerns/requests were discussed, and recommendations made.

- Councilman Robert Schmigel requested new "Playground" and "30 MPH" signs on Stenzil Street.
   The signs that are there were faded. New signs were installed by Matt Meisenburg (NT Signs and Signals Supervisor).
- City Clerk Donna Braun had a request from a resident for "Lane Change" signs at Ward Road and Warner Avenue since the turning lanes were changed. There were new signs installed by Meisenburg.
- 3.) Councilman Austin Tylec requested "No Parking" signs on Oliver Street just north of Linwood Avenue. There are vehicles parking next to the corner which is making it difficult for drivers to see vehicles coming from the north. The committee agrees with the request and would like council approval for the signs.
- 4.) Mayor Arthur Pappas requested new "10 MPH" signs in Mayor's Park. There is currently "5MPH" and "10 MPH" signs in the park and one of the signs was missing. Meisenburg will install new signs at the entrance, exit, in the park and he will make sure they match.
- 5.) Dawn Vollmer of 500 North Avenue is requesting a guard rail in front of her residence. The committee believes that a guard rail should be placed at the bend to protect the houses. The committee was informed that there could be liability issues with the guard rail. Member Frank advised Vollmer of this. The committee requests that the council look at installing a guard rail.
- 6.) Member Mark Lemke requested that the tree be trimmed on Tremont Street east of Oliver Street due to it blocking the view of the signal light. Meisenburg will have the tree trimmed.
- 7.) Fred Marazita requested that the tree be taken down at the corner of Hagen Avenue and Rumbold Avenue as it is blocking the view of the stop sign. The committee believes that the tree just needs to be trimmed and not taken down. Meisenburg will trim the tree.
- 8.) In September the committee requested curbs at Warner Avenue and Ward Road per the request of the property owner, Steve Toth. Toth's request stated that he would pay for the curbs. The council approved this request. Toth was informed of the approval and was advised by Frank that he would need to speak with City Engineer, Chelsea Spahr, prior to any work being started.



- 9.) Randy Szukala requested "Speed Limit" signs on Vanderbilt Avenue and Deerfield Drive by the North Tonawanda Intermediate School. There were no signs on either street. Meisenburg installed the signs. The area will also be monitored for speeding.
- 10.) Matt Meisenburg requested a new "No Parking" sign at the end of Wall Street going into Martinsville Park. The sign that was originally there was missing. Meisenburg installed a new sign.
