



LOCAL LAW No. 3 of 2024

A LOCAL LAW OF THE CITY OF NORTH TONAWANDA, NEW YORK TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPLE LAW SECTION 3-C

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of North Tonawanda in the county of Niagara, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative intent

It is the intent of the Local Law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the City of North Tonawanda, County of Niagara, State of New York pursuant to General Municipal Law 3-c, and to allow City of North Tonawanda to adopt a budget for (a) City purposes and (b) any other special or improvement district governed by the Common Council for the Fiscal Year 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by the General Municipal Law 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law 3-c, which expressly authorizes the Common Council to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Common Council.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Common Council of the City of North Tonawanda is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law 3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of the Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of the Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm, or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with Secretary of State.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THE EXTENT THAT THIS LOCAL LAW MAY CONFLICT WITH APLICABLE PORTIONS OF THE GENERAL CITY LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, IT IS STATED INTENTION OF THE CITY TO EXERCISE ITS AUTHORITY TO SPERSEDE AND AMEND, AS GRANTED UNDER THE MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, SECTION 10. Restore NY Communities Initiative-Round 9

Dear Honorable Body:

Empire State Development recently announced the Restore NY Communities Initiative grant with the purpose of "providing municipalities with financial assistance for revitalization of commercial and residential properties. The program encourages community development and neighborhood growth through the elimination and redevelopment of blighted structures."

Municipalities may apply for up to \$1 Million and eligible projects must "demolish, deconstruct, rehabilitate and/or reconstruct vacant, abandoned, condemned and surplus properties." Successful applications should demonstrate as many of the following as possible: project feasibility, project readiness, location within an urban downtown, location within a Brownfield Opportunity Area, consistent with community redevelopment plan, ability to induce commercial investment, and clearly identified need.

Given the criteria noted above, with a particular emphasis from Empire State Development on project feasibility and project readiness, the Department of Community Development believes that the 235 River Road mixed-use development project, led by 235 River Road LLC/Alpine Construction would make a strong application. The funding would be used to assist with demolition of existing structures on the site and associated site work to transform the site into a four story market-rate apartment building with 48 apartments and a four story/one story building with 39 market-rate apartments, 9,400 SF of first floor commercial space, clubhouse/resident amenity space, 166 parking spots, landscaping, lighting and utility connections.

The Department of Community Development will be publishing a required property assessment list for public review and is requesting authorization to conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 12th at 6:15 PM in the City Council Chambers to gain public feedback and input regarding the grant application, which is due on December 20th, 2024.

78 Bridge Street - Preferred Developer selection

Dear Honorable Body;

As you are aware, the City issued a Request for Development Proposals (RFP) for 78 Bridge Street, the city-owned former fire training site on Tonawanda Island, on May 1st, 2024. The city received 3 proposals by the July 1st, 2024 deadline. A review committee representing the Community Development Office, Engineering Office, Mayor's Office, Common Council, Lumber City Development Corporation, and Niagara County Brownfields Program was formed to review the proposals and conduct interviews with each developer.

All 3 proposals were submitted by well qualified development teams. Following a lengthy review, the review committee unanimously selected Visone Co. Site Development, LLC's "Bridge Street Landing" proposal.

Visone Co. Site Development, LLC is a Clarence-based developer, a full-service general construction firm, and property management company. The enterprise manages over 300,000 square feet of residential, commercial, retail, and light manufacturing real estate in Western New York. They have also successfully constructed over \$225 Million of municipal, industrial, residential, and commercial construction projects.

Visone Co.'s "Bridge Street Landing" project is a proposed 3-story 100,430 square foot mixed-use development which will include 73 market rate apartment units, 7 vacation rental/residence hotel units, and a waterfront commercial space ideal for a coffee shop/café type of tenant along the Little River waterfront. The unit mix will include predominately 1- and 2-bedroom units, with a few studios and 3-bedroom units. Additionally, the project includes a public access riverwalk and public benefit area. This project will be the first step to establish residential density on Tonawanda Island, and a unique design approach that will set a high standard for future Tonawanda Island development projects. Please see enclosed for additional information on the Bridge Street Landing project.

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The estimated total project cost is \$21,882,600 and Visone Co. Site Development is offering a purchase price for the property of \$400,900.

If selected by this Honorable Body, Visone Co. Site Development will have 60 days to execute a Land Disposition Agreement (LDA) with the City and 18 months from the execution of the LDA to secure financing and all required site plan and building approvals. Upon completion of these tasks, Visone Co. Site Development will have 6 months to begin construction and 24 months to complete the project.

On behalf of the selection committee, I respectfully request this Honorable Body select and designate Visone Co. Site Development, LLC as preferred developer for 78 Bridge Street, direct the City Attorney to draft a Land Disposition Agreement in accordance with the outline set forth in the original RFP, and authorize the Mayor to execute the Land Disposition Agreement with Visone Co. Site Development, LLC.
