

Dear Honorable Body,

Below for your consideration, are two (2) proposed ordinance revisions (in **bold print**) under North Tonawanda City Code Chapter 98 – Water.

#### § 98-8 Application for Water Service:

"When making "a" service application for newly built structures, the consumer must come in person, sign the application, "and" make "an" appointment for installation of the meter. "The consumer must pay the current cost and the current rate for the meter as well as the labor for installation of the meter, which is established on the City Website." The Property owner may furnish and install new City-approved meter with no charge by the City. Upon installation, meter must be inspected by the City Water Department.

#### § 98-11 Installation of Meters:

(c) Domestic Meters

The City of North Tonawanda will provide, and the Water Department will furnish (1) "I domestic meter up to and including a size of 5/8 by ¾ to a property at no cost to the homeowner/property owner. If additional 5/8 by ¾ meters are needed for the property, the property owner will be required to pay the current meter price and installation rate for each new and/or replacement meter. Once payment and installation is complete, the City of North Tonawanda will take ownership of all ¾ inch domestic meters once installed."

(1)(a) The Water Department shall install all such domestic meters, and the consumer shall be charged a service installation fee to be established by resolution of the Common Council. The Water Department will maintain, keep in repair and adjust all domestic meters except as may be otherwise provided.

#### § 98-11 (4) (added provision)

(4) If a meter is frozen, and needs to be replaced, the property owner will be charged the current cost and rate of a new meter and labor as provided on the City of North Tonawanda website.

#### § 98-14 Penalties for Offenses:

- (A) Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this chapter, to include tampering with the meter, shall be fined not less than \$250 nor more than \$1,000 for each offense. Further, if any monetary credit exists at the time a meter is found to have been tampered with, that existing credit shall be null and void. The Building Inspector and Code Enforcement Officer shall be responsible for enforcing compliance with this chapter.
- (B) If, as a result of gross negligence, a meter becomes frozen, inoperable, or needs to be replaced, the property owner will be charged the current cost and rate of a new meter and labor as provided on the City of North Tonawanda website.

If your Honorable body concurs, please pass the appropriate resolutions for the City of North Tonawanda to allow these additions to our North Tonawanda City Code, subject to further review by the City Attorney.

#### Summary

The City of North Tonawanda is issuing this Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit interested parties seeking to license dock space for commercial use along the Sweeney Canal Docks. The goal of this RFP is to attract a commercial user whose business presence enhances the seasonal traffic and vibrancy of the Erie Canal/Gateway Harbor area of North Tonawanda.

#### Site Details

The leasable area presented in this RFP is up to 50-feet of linear dock space at the eastern end of the Sweeney Canal Docks adjacent to Niagara River Cruises commercial dock space (see attached map). The dock space includes water service and 30 amp electric service. The site does not have boater pump-out facilities, dedicated restrooms, or dedicated parking. Public restrooms are available in nearby Gateway Harbor and public parking areas are available in close proximity.

#### Price and Term

The City of North Tonawanda intends to make the space available for license seasonally between May 15 and October 15 for a four-year term, 2025-2028 inclusive. The annual cost to license the space will be \$2,800 with the 2025 year pro-rated based on the start date of the contract. 

#### CONTRACTORS' AND VENDORS' INSURANCE COVERAGE AND CERTIFICATES

#### 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

A copy of such endorsement(s) must be furnished to the Certificate Holder.
- .6 Failure of the City to object to the Contractor's failure to furnish a Certificate or other evidence of the required insurance coverages, object to any defect in such Certificate or other evidence of coverage, or demand receipt of such Certificate or other evidence of coverage shall not be deemed a waiver of Contractor's obligation to furnish the required insurance coverages described herein. Nothing contained herein imposes on the City a duty or obligation to review any evidence of insurance coverages or issue any formal approval or acceptance of such evidence.
- .7 The Contractor's liability and indemnification of the City shall not be relieved or diminished by the Contractor securing insurance coverage in accordance with the City's requirements. 
