

Traffic Safety Minutes:

2021 DEC 29 AV9:58 NORTH TONAVANDA NV RECEIVED

The December 2021 meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1830 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: R. Frank, J. Sikora, M. Meisenburg, M. Lemke. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted, the following new concerns/requests were discussed, and recommendations made.

- 1.) Councilman Austin Tylec received a request for a stop sign at Tremont Street and Falconer Street. The Traffic Safety Committee and the Traffic Officer monitored the intersection. There is currently a stop sign at Payne Avenue and Niagara Street which are less than two tenths of a mile away from each other. The two streets in between these are Falconer Street and Bryant Street, neither of which are a cut through to anything. The Traffic Officer stated that the vehicles are not speeding from one stop sign to the other. The committee does not believe a third stop sign within two tenths of a mile is necessary.
- 2.) Mayor Pappas received a request for "No Parking" signs at Fairmont Avenue and Thomas Fox East due to a vehicle parking on the curve making it hard to pass. The committee and traffic officer monitored the intersection. Member Sikora also spoke to the neighbors. The neighbors tend to believe that if we place "No Parking" signs on one side of the street then vehicles would park on the other side of the street causing the same issue. This problem appears to be in the nicer months as the owner of the vehicle parks his vehicle in his driveway during the winter months. Member Sikora is going to reach out to the vehicle owner to see if he can find somewhere safer for him to park.
- 3.) Councilman Austin Tylec received a request from Sonia Rosen for "No Parking" signs at Oliver Street and Keil Street. The committee found that there are already marked parking spots in place for the residents and businesses in the area. Reducing these parking spots would make it so vehicles would have to park on the side streets. The side streets are already narrow so this would cause a different problem when vehicles try to pass each other on these side streets. The best option is to leave the intersection the way it is and for drivers to be careful when looking both ways.
- 4.) Member Frank received a complaint regarding speeding in the North Tonawanda High School parking lot. The School Resource Officer and the Traffic Officer have been monitoring the situation.
- 5.) Councilman Austin Tylec received a request for a stop sign at Wurlitzer Drive and Fairfax Avenue. This intersection was monitored in January and August of this year. The speed sign was

put on Wurlitzer Drive in July, August and October. The Traffic Officer has monitored Wurlitzer Drive numerous times this year and there have not been any major speeding or stop sign problems, nor have there been accidents. Placing three stop signs within two tenths of a mile will not solve this issue as stated in prior meeting minutes. There are allot of streets in North Tonawanda that have speeding problems and that is from drivers not following the law not due to lack of stop signs. These streets including Wurlitzer Drive will continue to be monitored with daily traffic enforcement, the traffic officer, the aggressive driving program and the selected traffic enforcement program. There was a traffic study completed on Wurlitzer Drive by a private contractor in the past and the stop signs were placed based on that study. The committee is available to help the city and/or engineering department if they wish to have a new study done.
