The Parks and Recreation Office, Community Development Office, and City Engineer's Office have been working to submit a grant application to the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership Program (ORLPP) for revitalization of the Memorial Pool complex.

The National Park Service (NPS) has announced the availability of \$224 million through the LWCF ORLPP program. This federal, nation-wide program enables urban communities to create new outdoor recreation spaces, reinvigorate existing parks, and form connections between people and the outdoors in economically underserved communities.

The grant application process includes submission to the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation (NYSOPRHP), which is due on March 11th, 2024. Highest scoring applications will then be sponsored by the NYSOPRHP and the project will be selected to prepare a full application to the NPS for final review and funding determination. The Federal application submission is due on April 20th, 2024.

The LWCF ORLPP program will provide 50% of the total eligible project cost, up to \$15,000,000, with a minimum 50% non-federal share match requirement. The non-federal share match can be sourced from NYS grants, city funds and sponsorships. The concept cost estimate for this project is approximately \$8.16 Million. Through this upcoming grant application, we believe the City could be eligible for up to \$4.08 Million in LWCF ORLPP program funds.

At this time we would like to request to this Honorable Council to authorize the City submit a grant application to the LWCF ORLPP program and commit to the required minimum match

The February meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1800 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: M. Meisenburg, R. Frank, J. Sikora, M. Lemke, A. DiBernardo, N. Ferguson, N. Phelps. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted, the following new concerns/requests were discussed, and recommendations made.

- 1. Vitaliy Bulava requested a terrace parking permit for 184 Schenck St. The committee denied the request due to there is not enough space creating a hazard.
- 2. Kelly Brant from 46 Leonhardt St. requested no parking signs on the south side of Leonhardt starting from Essie St. going east. The committee all agreed. The street is very narrow, Residents are parking RV's and Trailers on the street making no room for emergency vehicles, or even recreational vehicles to get down or even turn around. This is a major safety hazard.
- 3. Member Brennan received a complaint about vehicles driving off the curve heading north bound on Payne Ave between Fredericka St. and Daniel Dr. The curve has enough warning signs to make the area legal. The committee concluded that this situation is operator error. Member Frank will be setting up the police speed sign before the curve to slow vehicles approaching the area.
- 4. Mayor's office received a complaint at 1335 Sisson Dr. due to volleyball games and tournaments at a commercial level. During games traffic flow is at an all-time high! while vehicles are parked on lawns because there are no curbs and delivery trucks are unable to turn around making this a nuisance to the residents. The committee agreed to make code enforcement aware.
- 5. Member Sikora received a complaint 370 Oliver St. / Magic Glass. Resident parked to close to a fire hydrant and received a ticket. Come to find out there is a parking spot there that shouldn't be, the ticket was dismissed in court. Member Frank informed Patrol Captain Bush and advised the road guys not to ticket that spot until the Traffic Dept. can repaint the lines.
- 6. Member Meisenburg received a complaint from Jessica Hall. Stating at the crosswalk section at Niagara St. and Sweeney St. there are large bushes that block Sweeney St. near the crosswalk making it hard for pedestrians to cross. The committee agreed this is a serious safety issue and will be informing the DPW to trim back bushes for better visibility.

The next Traffic Safety Meeting will be held on March 18th, 2024.
