BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH TONAWANDA, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "CITY") AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$15,000,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY TO FINANCE THE CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S COMMUNITY CENTER

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of North Tonawanda (the "City") proposes to authorize the issuance of \$15,000,000 in serial bonds of the City to finance the construction and reconstruction of improvements to the community center in and for the City of North Tonawanda, including all ancillary, incidental and related equipment, machinery, apparatus, costs and expenses thereof (the "Project") at an estimated maximum cost of \$15,000,000; and

WHEREAS, immediately prior to the adoption of this resolution, the Common Council of the City determined pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation promulgated thereunder (collectively, "SEQRA"), determined that the Project constitutes a "Type II" action within the meaning of the SEQRA and therefore no further action under SEQRA with respect to the Project need be taken by the Town Board; and

- WHEREAS, the Common Council now wishes to appropriate funds for the Project and to authorize the issuance of the City's serial bonds and bond anticipation notes to be issued to finance said appropriation.
- NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL (the "Common Council") OF THE CITY OF NORTH TONAWANDA, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK HEREBY RESOLVES (by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of all the members of such body), AS FOLLOWS:
- **SECTION 1.** The City is hereby authorized to undertake the construction and reconstruction of improvements to the community center in and for the City of North Tonawanda, including all ancillary, incidental and related equipment, machinery, apparatus, costs and expenses thereof. It is hereby determined that the maximum estimated cost of the aforementioned class of object or purpose is \$15,000,000, said amount is hereby appropriated therefor and the plan for the financing thereof shall consist of (i) the issuance of up to \$15,000,000 in serial bonds of the City authorized to be issued pursuant to this resolution or bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of such bonds, (ii) the application of up to \$10,000,000 in grant monies expected to be received by the City to pay or reimburse costs of the Project (including the possible repayment of bond anticipation notes issued to finance such costs), the receipt of which shall reduce the amount of serial bonds authorized herein *pro tanto*, and (iii) unless paid from other sources, the levy and collection of taxes on all taxable real property of the City to pay the principal of such bonds or notes and the interest thereon as the same become due and payable.
- **SECTION 2.** Serial bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$15,000,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to provisions of Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (the "Law") to finance the Project.
- **SECTION 3.** It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforementioned class of object or purpose is twenty-five (25) years, pursuant to subdivision 12(a)(1). of paragraph a. of Section 11.00 of the Law.
- **SECTION 4.** The final maturity of the bonds herein authorized to be issued shall be in excess of five (5) years measured from the date of issuance of the first serial bond or bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this resolution.
- **SECTION 5.** The temporary use of available funds of the City, not immediately required for the purpose or purposes for which the same were borrowed, raised or otherwise created, is hereby authorized pursuant to Section 165.10 of the Law, for the capital purpose described in this resolution. This resolution shall constitute a declaration of "official intent" to reimburse the expenditures as part of the project described herein with the proceeds of the bonds and bond anticipation notes authorized herein, as required by United States Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.
- **SECTION 6.** Each of the serial bonds authorized by this resolution and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by Section 52.00 of the Law and said serial bonds and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall be general obligations of the City, payable as to both principal and interest by a general tax upon all the real property within the City without legal or constitutional limitation as to rate or amount. The faith and credit of the City are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest on said serial bonds and bond anticipation notes and provisions shall be made annually in the budget of the City by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the bonds and bond anticipation notes to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.
- **SECTION 7.** Subject to the provisions of this resolution and of the Law, pursuant to the provisions of Section 30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes or the renewals of said obligations, and of Section 21.00, Section 50.00, Section 54.90, Sections 56.00 through 60.00, Section 62.10 and Section 63.00 of the Law, the powers and duties of the Common Council relative to authorizing bond anticipation notes and prescribing the terms, form and contents as to the sale and issuance of bonds herein authorized, including without limitation the determination of whether to issue bonds having substantially level or declining

debt service and all matters related thereto, and of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, and the renewals of said bond anticipation notes, are hereby delegated to the City Clerk-Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of the City. However, prior to the sale and issuance of any obligations authorized herein, after reviewing such terms, form and contents, the Common Council shall adopt an additional resolution authorizing the City Clerk-Treasurer to issue said obligations authorized herein. Further, pursuant to subdivision b. of Section 11.00 of the Law, in the event that bonds to be issued for any of the objects or purposes authorized by this resolution are combined for sale, pursuant to subdivision c. of Section 57.00 of the Law, with bonds to be issued for one or more other objects or purposes authorized by this resolution or other resolutions of the Common Council, then the power of the Common Council to determine the "weighted average period of probable usefulness" (within the meaning of subdivision a. of Section 11.00 of the Law) for such combined objects or purposes is hereby delegated to the City Clerk-Treasurer, as the chief fiscal officer of the City.

- **SECTION 8.** The City Clerk-Treasurer is hereby further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to ensure the continued status of the interest on the bonds authorized by this resolution and any notes issued in anticipation thereof, as excludable from gross income for Federal income tax purposes pursuant to Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") and to designate the bonds authorized by this resolution and any notes issued in anticipation thereof, if applicable, as "qualified tax-exempt bonds" in accordance with Section 265(b)(3)(B)(i) of the Code.
- **SECTION 9.** The City Clerk-Treasurer is further authorized to enter into a continuing disclosure undertaking with or for the benefit of the initial purchaser of any of the bonds or notes authorized by this resolution in compliance with the provisions of Rule 15c2-12, promulgated by the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
- **SECTION 10.** The intent of this resolution is to give the City Clerk-Treasurer sufficient authority to execute those applications, agreements, instruments or to do any similar acts necessary to affect the issuance of the aforesaid serial bonds or bond anticipation notes without resorting to further action of this Common Council.
- **SECTION 11.** The validity of the bonds authorized by this resolution and of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds may be contested only if:
- (a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the City is not authorized to expend money; or
- (b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of such resolution are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of such publication; or

(c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

SECTION 12.
